



Look for the new red corner tags attached to every high-quality 120-mm mesh Kwik Goal net.



Small on mesh. Big on safety.

Nets with a smaller mesh help prevent entrapment and discourage climbing and other misuse that can lead to serious and sometimes even fatal injury. Plus, smaller mesh means more overall netting, a quality feature we weave into every net we make. This increases net durability and longevity and helps reduce the possible dangers associated with misuse and/or damaged nets.

Both the ASTM in the U.S. and the English FA provide guidelines that highly recommend that mesh width not exceed 4.72 inches (120 millimeters)—and Kwik Goal is the *only* U.S. manufacturer that strictly adheres to these guidelines.

Because when it comes to mesh, smaller is safer. And when it comes to net safety, Kwik Goal is #1.

Make safety a priority. Inspect your nets before and after every game.

Entrapment testing (top left) led us to reduce the mesh size on every Kwik Goal net from industry-standard 140 mm (5.5") to 120 mm. The velcro Net Fastener (top right) along with our patented Kwik Lock® Net Clips (bottom right) further enhance safety and ease of use.
